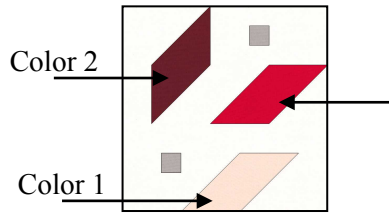


WINTER FLURRY BED SIZE ADDITION

- Note in the pattern when it references color 8, it will now be color 10 when making the Bed Size.

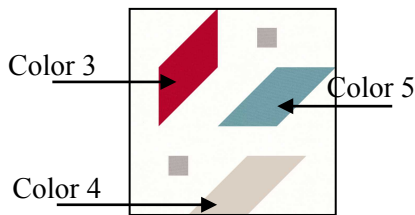
Block 1

Make 4 each for all sizes



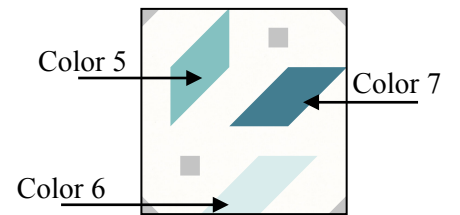
Block 2

Make 12 total for Baby and Throw sizes only



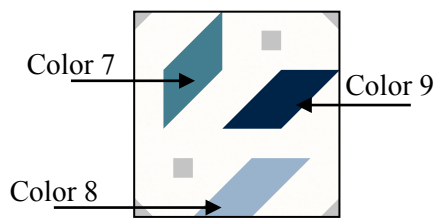
Block 3

Make 20 total for Throw and Bed size only



Block 4

Make 28 total for Bed size only



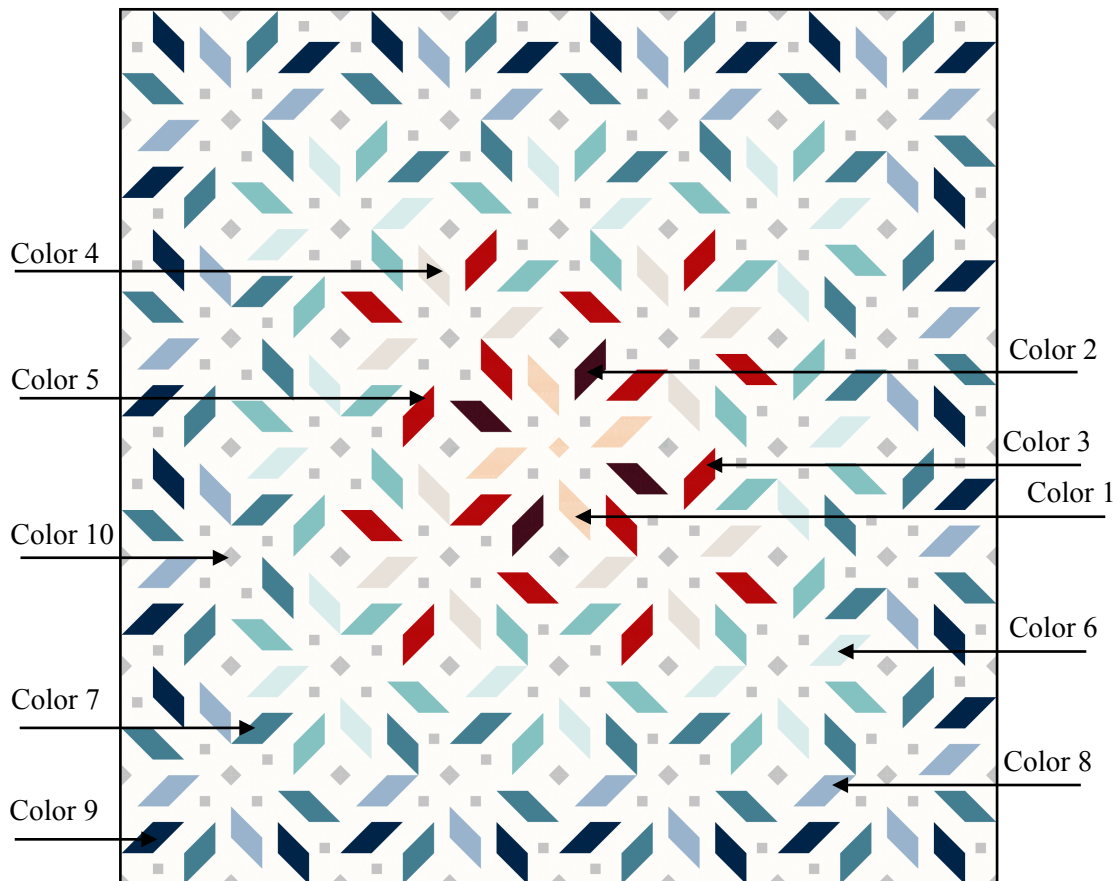
Flurry Block Construction

- Follow the instruction in the pattern but use these totals to make the flurry blocks for the bed size.
- You will need to cut (128) 1.5" x 3.5" strips
- Divide the total in 1/2 to (64) for each flurry block.













Flurry Corners

- Block 4 will get the same flurry corners as blocks 2 and 3

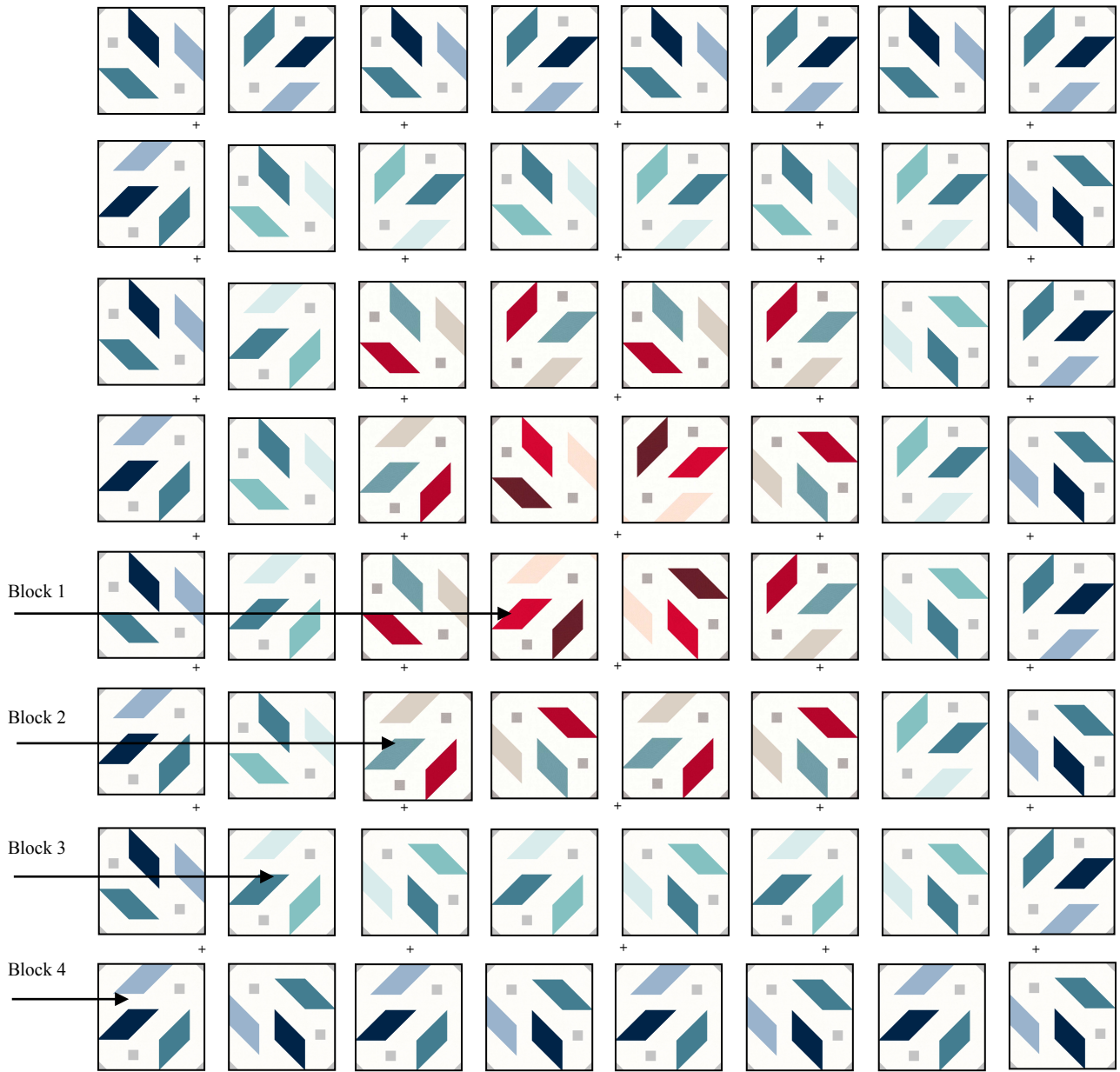
Bed Quilt Diagram



Note: To protect the integrity of the pattern the full cutting dimensions are not listed below, however they are the same as the throw size cutting dimension. The only difference is the total cuts needed. I have listed the totals in the same order as the original pattern.
